Collaborative Study Grant

Background:

- The St. Andrew's Society Los Angeles (SASLA) was established in 1930 and is a 501 (c) 3 organization whose mission is to promote Scottish history, traditions, and culture by developing educational and charitable undertakings that nurture relations between the Society, the people of Los Angeles and the greater community.
- In 2013 Barbara Grant made a generous gift to St. Andrew's Society Los Angeles in memory of her husband John Grant, a past president of the Society. The Society wishes to honor the purpose of this gift by making funding opportunities available to worthy recipients in the form of matching grants.

Program Overview:

- SASLA offers a matching grants program to provide one-time financial assistance to individuals from the Scottish community who wish to establish collaboration and study in their chosen field, by working at Children's Hospital Los Angeles
- OR to Southern California residents affiliated with Children's Hospital Los Angeles who wish to establish collaboration and study, in their chosen field with opportunities in Scotland.
- Grants of up to \$2,500 may be requested in one calendar year
- Grants are reviewed upon submission by the SASLA Grants Committee
- Recommendations are made by the Committee to the SASLA Board
- Any published material resulting from this exchange shall acknowledge the contribution from St. Andrew's Society Los Angeles
- Board Decisions are final and committee recommendations are not subject to appeal

Applicant Eligibility:

- Application must be submitted by an individual or an organization sponsor who is a resident of Scotland or is a Scot
- OR who is a resident of Southern California and is affiliated with Children's Hospital Los Angeles
- Applicants must submit a project budget demonstrating revenues or other contributions at least equal to the requested amount

How to Apply:

- Individuals who meet eligibility may submit an application using the attached cover sheet, a project budget and an application narrative not to exceed 500 words.
- Applicants may apply at any time during the year, however funding is limited and when the annual maximum dollar amount is reached, applicants will be so notified and be given the opportunity to be reconsidered in future years.

Application Narrative:

- Describe the specific project, event or occasion for which you are seeking funds
- Explain how the funds will benefit the above project, event or occasion
- Submission may be electronic or by mail

Funding Criteria:

- Appropriateness of purpose and quality of narrative
- Feasibility of reaching stated outcome/s
- Evidence that grant is being used as an enhancing not enabling grant
